



LOST ARROW AND EQUIPMENT **PROCEDURES**

- If an arrow or equipment (tie down pegs, target pins, arrow points etc) is lost then the following must be adhered to at ALL times.
- Upon the loss of an arrow the archer is to stop shooting and must look for it with the help of other archers after the next 2 ends of shooting (metal detectors are on the trollies)
- If after 2 ends it has not been found then ALL shooting is to stop and ALL archers are to assist in the search.
- If after 15 minutes the item has not been found then shooting may recommence and the lost arrow register must be completed with the assistance of the field captain.
- The field captain has the final decision to say when shooting may recommence.
- Searching will continue after each end until the end of the session.
- Archers are to ensure that they know the type of arrow with colour of fletching etc which is to be noted on the register.
- The field captain is responsible for passing on the information to King's school as soon as possible after the loss.
- It is the loser's responsibility to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to find the lost item.
- **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE FULL CARBON ARROWS TO BE USED ON THE AMHERST FIELD!**
